Long Distance Award Rules

The Morgan Owners Club of Australia offers a “Long Distance Award”. The purpose of this award is to encourage members enjoyment of their Morgan, to facilitate camaraderie with fellow enthusiasts, encourages keeping important elements of automotive history operating and provide enjoyment of the general public.

It also demonstrates the reliability of individual cars in achieving the distance travelled, and by displaying the plaques on the dashboard or in the engine bay, adds to their provenance.

The award takes the form of a small plaque with participant’s name, particulars of the vehicle/s, the relevant year involved and the distance/s travelled.

The rules are as follows:

1. The distance travelled must be more than 5,000 km or 3,100 miles during the MOCA year from 1st September to 31st August; or as adjusted for health lockdown restrictions or other impediments, as determined by the Club Captains, State Vice Presidents, &/or Club President.
2. Vehicles participating must not be ‘daily drivers’.
3. Owners of more than one Morgan can combine the distance travelled in each Morgan to reach the requisite distance.
4. The Award is open to all Life, Full, Family and Associate members in good standing of MOCA.
5. Members should accurately record the odometer readings of their car/s on or after September 1 of each year to ensure they have an accurate reading on or before August 31 of the following year. The Club will be relying on member’s honesty and integrity in the provision of accurate and truthful information.
6. Any and all defective odometers are the responsibility of the car’s owner/driver to repair. Estimates of distance travelled will be accepted, however the basis of the estimate should be provided with the application form.
7. The Club Captains, State Vice Presidents, &/or Club President reserve the right to challenge odometer readings and inspect odometers.
8. Dash plaques will contain the driver’s name, Morgan model & year, contest year, and distance driven.
9. Dash plaques will be presented as soon as possible after the conclusion of the grace period (1st – 30th September). Requests for plaques after the grace period will not be accepted.
10. Completed forms must be sent to MOCA via your MOCA State VP or directly to the Club Captain for consideration. Verbal information will not be accepted. A PDF copy of the completed application form can be emailed to the Club Captain (clubcaptain@morganownersclub.org.au)
